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NATIONAL VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS (NVQ)

WHAT IS AN NVQ?

A National Vocational Qualification is a work-based qualification that assesses the skills and knowledge a person needs against a prescribed criteria. Candidates must be able to demonstrate to a qualified assessor that they have the skills and knowledge to perform their chosen role or career path.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF AN NVQ?

For an individual

- It allows you to expand your knowledge and fulfill your career goals
- A flexible route to becoming qualified in the workplace with no examinations
- A practical demonstration of skills, knowledge and understanding - something that employers look for

- Access to recognised qualifications for employees with no formal education
- Puts work-based credentials on your CV
- Allows you to learn while you earn

Where there may be a shortfall in skills or knowledge needed to provide competence, further training can be recommended or provided where appropriate to help candidates gain the necessary skills and knowledge for their NVQ qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no specific entry requirements. To undertake an NVQ you simply need to be doing a role that matches the needs of the qualification to enable an evidence based portfolio to be collated covering your skills and knowledge.
