NATIONAL VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS (NVQ)

WHAT IS AN NVQ?

A National Vocational Qualification is a work-based qualification that assesses the skills and knowledge a person need against a prescribed criteria. Candidates must be able to demonstrate to a qualified assessor that they have the skills and knowledge to perform their chosen role or career path.

HOW IS IT ASSESSED?

Candidates need to demonstrate that they have the suitable skills, knowledge and understanding to carry out the tasks associated with their job role by creating a portfolio, and through practical observation.

Where there may be a shortfall in skills or knowledge needed to provide competence, further training can be recommended or provided where appropriate to help candidates gain the necessary skills and knowledge for their NVQ qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no specific entry requirements. To undertake an NVQ, you simply need to be doing a role that matches the needs of the qualification to enable an evidence based portfolio to be collated covering your skills and knowledge. An NVQ can be completed at your own pace as there is no set time limit on their completion.
